PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, education is one of the most important ways by which the Church fulfills its commitment to the dignity of the person and the building of community; and
- WHEREAS, Catholic schools in Indiana provide quality education to some 58,000 students and save Indiana taxpayers roughly 559 million dollars a year; and
- WHEREAS, Indiana will host over 10,000 Catholic school educators at the National Catholic Education Association Convention; and
- WHEREAS, the Archdiocese of Indianapolis welcomes educators from Catholic institutions from across the United States.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim March 25, 2008 as

CATHOLIC EDUCATOR DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
